Dearest sis,

Please excuse me for not writing sooner. We got your letter Thursday morning and your card this morning. I just got thru ironing a mess of curtains.

Last Saturday morning Harvey went to school as usual. In the afternoon Esther, Harvey, and I went with Uncle Elvin to F.O. to practice. All 3 of us haven't got anything except two songs, which are for everyone. We had to sit there all afternoon till the very end and then we sang our songs over about twice. We had fun listening to those kids, tho. You ought to hear Layton R., he just screams like. He says about two words and then takes a deep breath and so on. Edward

Sekrt has a German piece, it ends up with, "Putz deine nose frity". He started crying when he said it & when he got thru with that line, he got out his handkerchief & wiped his eyes & nose. Preacher had to laugh and he ^{said} to Edward, "Ja, jetzt putz deine nose man sordlich". (I don't know if I spelled all that right). Deloris & Russell W. also have German pieces.

Sunday morning we went to S.S. & church. In the afternoon we stayed at home, it was too hot to go anywhere. Mam got a notion to go to the dance that night, so all of us went. If it hadn't been on Sun. I guess dad wouldn't have gone. Homer, Esther, and I went back with Uncle Al, so ^{that} we could stay longer.

We weren't at Drinkman's dance the other Sun. so I don't know about Verne K. But Ora told us too Sun. night that she had been drunk. She was drunk Sun. nite at Madeline again. I danced with her at the beginning (I guess maybe she was

sober then yet) and I asked her about Rev. Vernon said she was about my size & skinny, too. Vernon is writing at the table at Sodrys whenever they have company. Later (at the dance) Vernon came to me again and said she was tired & everything else. I thought she was acting kind of dizzy.

had a break cartwheel on sun morning.
She couldn't even keep it on her head.

Dad went to St. Louis Tues.
with 75 young roosters. He also
took Uncle Charley's hog, one of
Edwin Wessler's cows, and a calf of
Burklegie's. We got \$35. for our roosters.

Clarence & Adele are going to
move up to Clarence's dad Aug. 1st.
Ed. Jaerling does not like it and
fussed at Clarence and asked him
what he was going to do up there
on the prairie, whether he was

Gwickens started threshing Wednesday afternoon. They got in 300 bushels. Lunks threshed Thursday afternoon. They got a little more than Gwickens. Albert Meyers started this morning & I think they'll get them. Walter Backham is helping Dad. Tomorrow Bueneman will thresh (if it don't rain) and dad has to go with the truck.

Dad hauled two loads of hay with the truck from Uncle Edwin Becker for Uncle Carl Becker yesterday (Thurs.) He hauled another load this morning.

Uncle Charley L. was here yesterday morning. He got our Montgomery Ward catalogue to order something for their oil stove. We did ^{not get} any picture of Darleen & Maynard yet. I know they have them tho because

I saw the package in Thoroughmore car, ha! ha! Darleen said so too. Darleen is sporting white shoes now.

Harvey did not have ^{any} school Weds. morning, Preacher is still sick yet or whatever is the matter with him, Lester N. called up this morning & said they wouldn't have school tomorrow either & no choir tonight.

Homer did answer Vincent Herdt's card today! And how. Esther & I wrote the whole thing & he copied it. Just like boys, eh! He sent it Mon. morning.

I believe I'll sign off for tonight & maybe I can think of more tomorrow morning, I hate right we got 2 letters from Aunt G illie this morning Sat. morning

Tuesday I canned 2 qts. beets, 1 qt. kohlrabi, 2 qts. green beans, and 1 qt. pickles. Variety, ha! ha! I am going to can about 1 1/2 qt. pickles today again.

Don't worry about envelopes,
paper + stamps we've got a good
supply of all.

I don't know yet what we
are going to do tomorrow. Homer +
Harvey want to go to Rehmeiers. All
those boys down there want to go
swimming at Kruegers.

We never heard anything about
a little "kid" being run over at Schlesburg.
It must not have been bad or we would
have heard it.

Did Enrice Dahn write already?
I told her the address but maybe
she'll forget it.

Mom said we'll all have to go
to the dentist real soon yet before school
starts. You sure must have a lot
of toothache.

I guess I'll quit now or I'll have to
send it in two envelopes ha! ha!
