walked. Esther & I stayed at home. Homer & Harvey went to
Ore. Tomite, Esther, Evelyn, Alvin & I went to Warrenton show.
Saw Warner Baxter & Joan Blondell in "Vogue of 1938." All in color.

MON. 1939 - Sewed on butterfly quilt. Washed
clothes after dinner.

TUES. 1940 - Packed clothes all morning. Dad, Homer, &
Ora took me to Wentzville. Bus late on account of snow.
Rode on Katherine's lap to Wentzville. Sat in different
bus at Warrenton & took it to Kirkwood. Had to
wait at K. for the following bus for our baggage. Was 8
when we got to Mr. Davis. He gave Katherine and I supper.
Went to bed at 13.

THURS. 1941 - Taught school. ~~met~~ Miss Clarke &
I went with the Rutherford's to Unionville to get
Miss Clarke's car. Knitted tonite. Hat
knitting yarn from Red Cross at N. to knit a sweater

JANUARY 3

SUN. 1937 - Cold. Went to Sunday School & church.
Mildred & Ora here for dinner & afternoon. Ice cream.
Went to show at night (Hyman, Homer, Vernon H., Esther, Evelyn) saw
"College Holiday" (Burt, Ella, Jess Clegg, Martha Raye) pretty good.

MON. 1938 - Homer & Harvey down at Mildred. Washed clothes
this afternoon. Wrote class letter. Mildred went to store.
Stopped in here.

TUE. 1939 - Sewed on embroidery this morning.
Went to club meeting at Bollman's this afternoon.
Exchanged apron patterns. Sewed coffee,
cookies & rolls.

WED. 1940 - Went to school today. Studied
tonite. Had assembly this morning. Dean
Inniss, University of Southern California
Speech Teacher, read some poems.

FRI. 1941 - Taught school. This evening
immediately after school I left with Miss
Clarke for Columbia. She had to arrange for
dropping courses at the university. Went
through Brookfield, Keytesville, & Fayette. arrived
here at 9.

JANUARY 4

Mon. 19³⁷ - Homer, father, & I went to Zweckens butchering.

Plenty help. Found out that Uncle Charly, Parker & Maynard were here & in on back porch and made more.

Uncle Charly & Dad went to St. Charles. Homer & Harvey hunting tonite.

Tue. 19³⁸ - Ironed clothes. Mailed class letter.

Irvin W. here shredding corn. Paul Berkemier here want mom & I to help butcher tomorrow. Mrs. B. sick. Homer & Harvey went hunting. Got two opposumms.

Wed. 19³⁹ - Sewed on butterflies. Cut comfort in frame began tufting it. Mildred here this afternoon. League meeting tonite but postponed till tomorrow night on account of

Thur. 19⁴⁰ - Went to classes. Went to library this afternoon and studied. Tonite played cards with Helen, Mrs. Davis, and Dave. Wrote letter to Esther tonite.

Fri. 19⁴¹ - In Columbia. With mother Miss Clark to University at first. She brought me to Vernie Backhouse's place. Stayed with her until noon. Came home for dinner. Went back after dinner. Stayed for supper. Vernie & I went to the show. The thing called Love

JANUARY 5

Tues. 19³⁷ - Homer, Harvey, and Warren Palmerice got a coon last nite. This tonite. Went to Zweckens again today (Esther & I). Johnay took us home.

Wed. 19³⁸ - Mom, dad, & I went to Berkemiere. Butchered 3 hogs. Hulda & Wilbert O. helped too. Irvin & Kermit at home, shredding corn. Tonite Ella River planned on serenading Edward Hermann. Didn't work out right, he beat it out. Saw his wife but not the baby. Homer, Harvey, & I, mildred, Esther & I went down together.

Thurs. 19³⁹ - Finished tufting comfort this morning. Began sewing wine print dress I got for Christmas. Tonite went to League meeting. Served cheese & crackers & coffee.

Fri. 19⁴⁰ - Went to classes this morning.

Went to library this afternoon and studied. Tonite Katherine & I went with Jacquette to mail health letters up town. Played cards with Katherine, Dave, & Mrs. Davis.

Sun. 19⁴¹ - In Columbia. Vernie & I went to Ev. Student Chapel. Talked to Kenny & Henry & George. Sat with Henry in church. Miss Clark & I started back at 4:30. Got to Lemmons at 8:30. Came through Kirksville.

JANUARY 6

Wed. 1937 - Washed clothes after dinner. Sewed. After supper Homer went to T.O. to get radio battery. Later him & Harvey went hunting but didn't get anything. Got new expectant glove from C.M.O. (Pennies from Heaven - Our Little Parade)

Thurs. 1938 - Mom & I went to Berkemeyer's. Hulls B. there too. Made sausage. Irvin & Kermit helped shuck corn at home. Hot 7.5° from Berkemeyer's.

Fri. 1939 - Sewed on wine dress. Harvey went to basketball game at Marthaville tonite. Lost.

Sat. 1940 - Cleaned room and washed clothes this morning. Afternoon Katherine & I went up town. Snowed tonite. Put jigsaw puzzle together and wrote letter to Mildred.

Mon. 1941 - Taught school. Knitted. Wrote to Doris tonight. Ray called from Kirksville tonite.

JANUARY 7

THURS. 1937 - Ugly weather; Rainy. Ice on trees. Saw red fox in trap. Dad took mom to Ladies Aid. Sewed on scarf. Etta Williams sent us her quilt patches.

Fri. 1938 - Pressed my dress & H. pants. Herman Backhouse here with aerial pictures of farms. Uncle Charlie here - butchered calf. Tonite Mildred and Ora here, got things for their butchering.

Sat. 1939 - Churned butter. Took music lessons at Marie Brink this afternoon. Set hair.

Sun. 1938 - Heavy snow, didn't go to church. Ma May, Jo, & I made soup for dinner. Studied this afternoon. Tonite Mary, Bert, Kenneth Cooley and played cards.

Tues. 1940 - Taught school. Tonite Howard Bogorac, H.S. teacher & I went to Unionville & Holler - visited & went to the Show. Saw Knute Roseau (Pat O'Brien & Hale Page). Letter from Mildred. Wrote to Mildred & Oileen.

JANUARY 8

FRI. 1937 - Rain. Ice on trees. Cut and sewed pink flannel pajamas. Two weeks ago since Ruth Barkemire (4 yrs.) died on Christmas night (Dec. 25, 1936).

SAT. 1937 - Dad went to Wright City. Scrubbed kitchen. Set hair. Took down Christmas tree. On her to get things for butchering. Sonita, Homer & Harvey went to Edwards' Newman's barbecue again. Dined lunch there.

SUN. 1938 - Went to S.S. + church. Afternoon Charles, Frederick, Alma B., + Eleanor came over to go to F.O. to underorate tree but when we got there they were done.

MON. 1938 - Went to classes. Studied at library this afternoon. Went to basketball game tonite with Katherine, Rebecca, and Mary Kirkeville (21) vs Springfield (16).

WED. 1938 - Taught school today. Two letters from Ray. Knitted. Two ladies, Mrs. Quigley + Mrs. Edwards at school this evening. Met acquainted party Fri. nite. Wrote to Ray.

JANUARY 9

SAT. 1937 - Sewed on pajamas. Uncle Charlie was here and brought a box of candy from Darleen. Snowed a little tonight.

SUN. 1938 - Went to S.S. and church. Stayed home this afternoon. Ed. Backhouse here a few min. Wrote letter, Ervin, Elvin, + I went to Defiance medicine show. Homer, Harvey, Charles + Edgar went too.

MON. 1938 - Sewed on butterflies. Sonita, One took Esther + I to choir practice. Homer + Harvey went hunting, got a coon.

TUE. 1938 - Went to classes. Afternoon at 4 Katherine and I went to the Rural Leadership Club and joined. Served cookies and cocoa. Wrote letter to Marie Brink. Standard tonite. Two girls stayed here at Mrs. Davis'. Tonite because ^{she} had ^{the place they stay} a birthday party.

THURS. 1938 - Taught school today. Washed clothes tonite. Letter from Esther. Knitted. Wrote to Esther.

JANUARY 10

SUN. 1937 - Got up late. Went to SS. + church. In the afternoon Walter Palmer + family were here and also Eleanor + Grace. Went skating + on frozen snow. That night Pete + Edwin came and we played cards.

MON. 1938 - Mom, dad, Horace, Esther, + I went to Mildred + Ara, butchering. Mr. + Mrs. Buerneman helped too. Harvey went to school again. Tonight Mildred, Esther, + I went to O. Schlemmer's. Picked out a play for our club to give. Ara, Horace, + Harvey went hunting. Not ~~too~~ one appearance.

TUE. 1939 - Washed clothes after dinner. Sewed on butterflies.

WED. 1940 - Went to classes. Signed up with Independents in Basketball Tournament. Studied tonight. Assembly this morning. Dr. Hewitt spoke.

FRI. 1940 - Taught school. Tonight had get-acquainted party. Musical program. Served sandwiches, coffee, + cocoa. After party I went with Buttermores to Kirkville. Arrived there at 12 (midnite). No one knew I was coming.

JANUARY 11

MON. 1937 - Sewed on pajamas and started Grace's dress. Dad went to Wentzville and had truck trouble. Andrew Nader took fed home from Mr. Lipofsky. Got a letter from Ruth.

TUE. 1938 - Dad, Mom, Esther, + I help Mildred + Ara butcher again. Made sausage. Mr. + Mrs. Buerneman there too. This afternoon Mrs. Buerneman, Esther, + I went to club meeting at Linke. Mrs. Clinton there a short while. Demonstration on preparing school lunches.

WED. 1939 - Ironed clothes all day. Tonight Harvey went to card party + C. Scherff's for Ruth Simpson. Won 1st prize (deck of cards).

THUR. 1940 - Went to classes. Didn't have school org. + mtg. this afternoon. Had hair set. Went uptown this evening + had picture taken. Current Affairs test this morning. Studied tonight.

FRI. 1940 - Rileen, Katherine, + I went uptown. Ate dinner at Joe's. Bought a sloppy Joe sweater. At 3 o'clock I went to the dentist (Dr. Thomas) Katherine went with me. Had to come back. Filled 3 teeth. Went to see Dr. Lee before going to dentist. Ray took me out to dinner at Evanson's tonight. Later went to K. C. O.S. dance (4 freshman + senior). Negro orchestra (not 5th grade).

JANUARY 12

TUES¹⁹ 37 - Sewed on Gracie's dress. Dad went to New Melle to fix truck. Sent for picture of Barnyard Follies.

WED¹⁹ 37 - Went to church this morning. Rev. H. Kalkbrenner gave a trial sermon. Voted 37-40 for him. Didn't decide yet whether or not he'd take it. Pretty good but doesn't talk too loud. Gave us some germs to plant. This afternoon I began sewing on my deck rug and sewed on my butterfly quilt. ~~met friends~~ came home to me. Stayed at home. Dined with Uncle Bill & basketball game.

THURS¹⁹ 37 - Sewed on embroidery. Finished wine print dress. Tonite mom, dad, Esther, + I went to Herman Buinenman. Langenbacher had a meeting there about soil planning.

FRI¹⁹ 37 - Went to classes. Studied this afternoon. Wrote to Esther + Lucile Meyer to me. Set Katherine's hair.

SUN¹⁹ 37 - Slept late. Katherine + I went to Joe's Cafet mat Aileen there for dinner. This afternoon Ray + I went walking. We stopped with Aileen + Katherine. Tonite Ray + I went up town. Came home at 10 + then I went with Rutherford's to Lemons.

JANUARY 13

WED¹⁹ 37 - Rain. Melted snow. Radio broke. Finished pajamas. Harvey came home late from school and Esther and I milked 10 cows by ourselves.

THURS¹⁹ 37 - Uncle Charlie got sick last night. His dinner mom + dad went up there. They had taken him to Basson's hospital this morning. Washed clothes. Sewed on rug. Smiled Herman + Mildred here. Homer, Harvey, Ora, Clarke, + Frederick went hunting. Homer + Harvey stayed home when they got back from hunting. Hot 70 degrees. Uncle Al said Uncle Charlie coming back Sunday.

FRI¹⁹ 37 - Sewed on embroidery. Mildred + Ora here this afternoon. Uncle Charlie here this dinner. Washed some clothes. Tonite Harvey went to basketball game at Wright City. Lost.

SAT¹⁹ 37 - Ironed clothes. Went up town after dinner. Got new shoes + shirt. Set Mrs. Davis hair. ~~Studied~~ Studied.

MON¹⁹ 37 - All dressed for school + then notified there would be no school. Furnace pipe leaked. Knitted. Wrote to Aileen, Mildred, + Ruth. This evening Miss Clarke, Bogener, + I went to Unionville. Ridden horse.

JANUARY 14

THURS. 19 - Got clean letter by mail.
Still raining; awful muddy. Not a grey fox in trap. Sewed friendship quilt names tonite & saved out a patch for Horine K. Harvey stayed at Meaders on account of weather.

Fri. 1938 - Mildred went home at 6 this morning, stayed last night. Sent boy home, they got up late, didn't hear alarm. Ironed clothes. Sewed on rug. Made overnight cookies.

Canned beef. Wrote S. S. lesson. Dorothy Engleage has scarlet fever. One girl broke out with something in high school yesterday.

Sat. 1939 - Met Homer & Mildred. Dad to Wentzville. After dinner dad & Harvey went to Mildred's too. Scrubbed kitchen, churned butter, darned stockings & fixed on clothes. Took bath.

Sun. 1940 - Pushed car on street & helped get it started. Didn't go to S. S. and church. Snowed last night - very deep. Took pictures. Studied. After dinner Katherine & I borrowed snowshoes and went walking. Studied tonite. Wrote letter to Mildred.

Tues. 1941 - Taught school today. Wrote some of the others went to Unionville. I stayed home with toothache. Letter from Ray. Wrote to Ray & to Esther.

JANUARY 15

Fri. 19 - John Bergmeier was here & bought white calf. Took bath. Went to Mary Britton play at Richmond School. (Homer, Warren, Harvey, Esther, & I) "Mother Mine". It was good only characters needed prompting.

Sat. 1938 - Ironed clothes. Set hair. Washed car. Mom & dad went to store this morning. Eddie Homer, Esther, & I went to dance at New Melts. Not many there, few from F. O. Alvin Currin & Amie were there too.

Sun. 1939 - Went to S. S. & church. Afternoon visited Theo. Beckers.

Mon. 1940 - Went to classes. Studied this afternoon and tonite.

Wed. 19 Taught school.

JANUARY 16

SAT. 1937 - Sat here, wrote S.S. lesson. Scrubbed. At nite went to New Melle dance. Nobody there so whole gang went to Y. (Ester, Ervin, Pete, & I). Al. Wesslers got new 1937 Chev. His May brought Kodak back in afternoon.

Sun. 1938 - Went to S.S. & church. Darlene & Maynard was home with us. Uncle Elvin & Aunt Clara went to St. Louis to see Uncle Charlie. Stopped in this afternoon, said he coming home Tues. or Thurs. Monday did went to Elvin Baumier's tonite. Mother, Harvey, Ervin, Esther, Alvin, & I went to Ora & Mildred. Played cards.

Mon. 1939 - Sewed on butterfly quilt.

Tues. 1940 - Went to classes. Studied this afternoon and tonite. Went to basketball game tonite. Kirkville played Warrensburg and lost 30-28. Wrote letter to Corinne Paul, got a letter from her this morning.

Thurs. 1941 - Taught school. ^{also, from mother} Miss Clarke, & I started to Unionville but came back because of fog.

JANUARY 17

SUN. 1937 - Went to S.S. & church. Took books along for Josie who is sick in bed. Mildred & Ora for dinner & afternoon. At 3:30 (evening) Lewis & Kermit W. & Warren R. came in new car & gave us ride. At nite we played cards.

Mon. 1938 - Sewed on each rug. Washed clothes. Sent letter to Aunt Hilda and two Kodak films. Harvey stayed at home - fed col. Charles Bass here, grinding feed. Elvin working here (road work). Got play books by mail.

Tues. 1939 - Washed clothes this morning. began snowing this dinner. Sewed on butterfly quilt.

Wed. 1940 - Went to classes. Had assembly this morning. Mr. C. W^m Duncan, a Philadelphia journalist, spoke. Good. Studied at library this afternoon. Studied tonite.

Fri. 1941 - Taught school. Letter from Ray.

JANUARY 18

Mon. 1937 - Sun shined all day. Washed clothes; didn't wash since week before last. Nearly fell over when Harvey came home from school with letter from Cine Lehman. She sent me quilt block to sew on for her friendship quilt.
Tues. 1937 - Harvey stayed at home again. Sewed on rug. Put wood in basement.

Wed. 1939 - Began cutting & piecing log cabin quilt blocks.

Thurs. 1940 - Went to classes. Studied at library this afternoon. Went to three one-act plays tonite; Mrs. Davis, Katherine, Helen and I. Studied tonite.

Fri. 1941 - Miss Clarke, Elab May Wallace, & I went to Killesville this morning. Spent several hours at Mrs. Davis' saw Ray. Came home to Lemons at about 7 o'clock. Washed clothes tonite.

JANUARY 19

Tues. 1937 - Sent class letter to Mary Braxton. Home & Dad went to St. Louis and came back late. Had to do feeding (kennel &c). Sewed on Louise Lehmann quilt patch. Male stepped on Fido's back and crippled him.
Wed. 1938 - Harvey went to school. Put quilt in frame. Began quilting this afternoon. (Red, white, & blue starquilt)

Thurs. 1939 - Pieced together log cabin quilt blocks.

Fri. 1940 - Went to classes. Afternoon Mrs. Davis, Helen, Katherine, and I went to show. "Rulers of the sea" (Douglas Fairbanks, Jr.) and "High School" (Jane Withers). Pretty good. Studied tonite. Letter from Esther.

Sun. 1941 - Bogue, Miss Clarke, & I went to Neth. S.S. this morning. Only about 8 there. Conducted our own S.S. Played around all day. Took pictures of Bessie Ruth.

JANUARY 20

Wed. 1937 - Rained last night. Fis died this morning,
Homer took him to the creek. He was 13 1/2 yrs. old.
Sewed on my friendship quilt this morning and on
Kreiss dress this afternoon.

Thurs. 1938 - Mom went with Uncle Edwin & Aunt Clara to St. Louis. Uncle
Charles came back. Not one bunch of pictures by mail.
Quilted all day. Wrote SS. lesson tonite.

Fri. 1939 - Finished piecing log cabin quilt blocks
today. Tonite we kids went with Meyers to basket-
ball game at Howell. Augusta lost all 3 games.

Sat. 1940 - Cleaned our room. Got letter from
Mildred. Washed my clothes. Studied
this afternoon and tonight.

Mon. 1941 - Taught school. Letters from Mildred
& Ray. Wrote to Mildred tonite.

JANUARY 21

Thurs. 1937 - Began snowing this morning kept it up most of the
day. Sewed Kreiss dress; patched my old pajamas
& put them away; and sewed snaps in my new
ones. Uncle Edwin walked out here this afternoon.

Fri. 1938 - Quilted all day. Homer worked on road. Mildred
came after dinner - helped quilt. Sonie, Kermitt, Homer,
Ewin & Lettie, Alvin, + I went to St. Charles - Rural youth meeting.
Only 4 other boys from Black Walnut (Robert M.) there. Some
lady from Columbia there. Not bad - didn't get far with meeting.

Sat. 1939 - Went to Marie Brink this morning for music
lessons. Afternoon dad, mom, Homer, Harvey, went to Oat Mill.
Cleaned kitchen, set hair, baked cake.

Sun. 1940 - Went to S.S. and church (Methodist)
with Mrs. Davis + Mary. Wrote letter to Mildred.
Washed and set hair. Studied.

Tues. 1941 - Taught school. Letter from
Willa Ruth. Wrote to Ray tonite.
Began reading "Her Father's Daughter" by
Sara Strutton Porter.

JANUARY 22

FRI. 1937 - Harvey visited school bus. Got a card from Nora Wildschutty, she invited Esther & I to a pinocchio card party Sun. eve. Homer sick in bed all day, snowed most of day. Harvey measured it - 7 inches.

SAT. 1938 - Quilted, washed & set hair. Scrubbed kitchen. Baked a cake. Rolled up quilt - put it aside until next week. Were invited to shower for Mr. & Mrs. Elmo Heuman but didn't go. Sent present down to Mildred. Homer & Harvey went to shower Tonite.

SUN. 1939 - Went to S.S. & church. Afternoon mom, dad, Esther, & I went to Arthur Schlemmer. Chas. & Lillie Becker there too. Tonite went along with Harvey, Esther, & Ervin to Waterville show. "Always Goodbye" (Barbara Stanwyck) (Herbert Marshall).

MON. 1940 - Went to classes. Ironed clothes this afternoon. Studied Tonite. Test in Organization and Management this afternoon. Wrote to Doris Holt.

WED. 1941 - Taught school today. Letter from Esther. Wrote to Esther Tonite. Knitted.

JANUARY 23

SAT. 1939 - Cloudy, lewed. Wrote S.S. lesson. Homer got out of bed after dinner. Set hair.

SUN. 1938 - Went to S.S. & church. Rained all day. Stayed home all day. Rev. Kellebrunner wrote - not coming to F. C. Sonita Elvira & Ervin came - played cards.

MON. 1939 - lewed on butterfly quilt. Washed clothes. Snowing. No choir practice Tonite.

TUES. 1940 - Went to classes. Went uptown for dinner with Oileen. Got a letter from Cecile Meyer. Had two classes this afternoon. Went to school show at Kennedy Swanee River 19 (Don Ameche, Andrea Lee & Ladd). Studied Tonite.

JANUARY 24

after practice.
Eva L. got first prize & Verne J. got booby at playing picnicle.

Sun. 1937 - Went to S.S. & church. Mildred ate dinner here & later

came home. Last night Esther, Eva, Alvin, & I went to Nease party. Kenny, Lucille O., Verne & Clarence J., Eva L., & Lester C. there. Pretty good time. Right before we went home Verne broke down with chair. *Served sandwiches.* cake, & coffee.

Mon. 1938 - Put up quilt again - quilted all day. Raining yet and windy. Hot rest of pictures today - not as hot.

Tues. 1939 - Started another log cabin quilt. Sewed 25 blocks. Ironed a little.

Wed. 1940 - Went to classes. Didn't go to assembly. Went to library this afternoon. Had a tea this afternoon but didn't go. Studied tonite. Got a letter from Corinne Paul.

JANUARY 25

Mon. 1937 - Received thermometer from Verne, but not the picture. Sewed on scarf. Vic Human & Ed Hissmann here this afternoon. Vic Human paid off mortgage on Brockie's house. Went to mail box and met carrier for money order.

Tues. 1938 - Quilted all day - just about done. Snowed a little last nite - cold & windy today. Dad went to Hissmann & F.O. supposed to practice play tonite but postponed it - too cold.

Wed. 1939 - Went along with Horner to Mildred to stay a few days. Shredding corn there. Eddie Meyer & Virgil Dorman helping. Washed & stretched curtains for east room down-stairs. Put up shades & curtain rods in that room. Churned butter. Stayed at Mildred tonite.

Thurs. 1940 - Went to classes. Test in English 8C. Went up town with Aileen for dinner. Studied this afternoon and tonite.
