 Tue. 1938 - In bed all day. Mom and dad went to F.O. after lunch. Mildred went to St. Charles today. Got a permanent.

Wed. 1939 - Sewed on butterflies. Washed some clothes. Went to church tonite. Letter came back home, & stayed at Mildred after church.

Fri. 1940 - Went to classes. Text in Rural Education. This afternoon Mrs. Davis, Katherine, & I went to see "Gone With the Wind" (Clark Gable, Vivien Leigh, Leslie Howard, and Olivia de Havilland). Good. Lasted a little longer than 3 1/2 hrs.

MARCH 30

TUE. 1937 - Sewed on friendship quilt, pieced blocks together. Washed clothes. Returned ~~to~~ to Sears & Roebuck ship. Letting letters from Bernice Parke, sent quilt blocks back. To note Jack Schneider & Vera Pilman were here several minutes. Vera looking for school.

Wed. 1937 - In bed all day. Seven days now and swelling isn't down yet. Got a letter from Davis. Creek was out in places ~~last night~~ this morning. Vic Heuman got dam after dinner. ^{rained & gailed (larger than logs) this evening.} Broke several windows. Creek ^{was out!}

Thurs. 1937 at Mildred. Ironed some clothes.

Sat. 1940 - Washed my clothes. Washed my hair. Ironed clothes. Went uptown this evening. Wrote to Esther.

MARCH 31

Wed. 1937 - Sewed on friendship quilt, piecing blocks together. Dad & Homer were at S.O. crushing limestone at Smithmeyers. Weighd ourselves on hog scale - 117 1/2 lbs.

Thurs. 1938 - In bed nearly all day. Went to table for meals. Had a real storm everywhere last nite. Harlan girls came for a bucket of milk.

Fri. 1939 - ^{at Mildred.} Baked cake. Homer, dad, Virgil Dorman, & Elsie Mayer sawing wood here this afternoon. Washed clothes.

Mr. Davis & Mrs. Davis' sister & brother-in-law were here today.
Sun. 1940 - Went with Ha, Jo, and Kith. to Baptist S.S. and later Kith., Evelyn H., and Vera May & went to Presbyterian church. Walked this afternoon and studied. Wrote to Mildred.
