Please verify the bonds and check against the list and if they do not agree, report the discrepancy at once to the Treasury Department, Division of Loans and Currency, Washington, D. C.

For your information, there is enclosed a copy of Treasury Department Circular No. 560, governing Adjusted Service Bonds. This circular gives instructions regarding payment of the bonds to the registered owner, or, in case of his death or incompetence, to the representative of his estate, and also gives instructions for action to be taken in case of loss or destruction of the bonds. It is suggested that you retain this circular for future reference.
