

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL**

Appeal from classification by local board or board of appeal must be made by signing appeal form on back of Selective Service questionnaire (Form 40) at office of local board, or by filing written notice of appeal, within 10 days after the mailing of this notice. Before appeal, a registrant may file a written request for appearance within the same 10-day period; and if he does so, the local board will fix a day and notify him to appear personally before the local board. If this is done, the time to appeal is extended to 10 days from the date of mailing of the new Notice of Classification (Form 57) after such appearance. There is a right in certain dependency cases of appeal from appeal board decision to the President; see Selective Service Regulations. For advice, see your Government appeal agent.

Your request must include the following information:  
 1. The reasons for your request for reference to another local board.  
 2. The designation (name and location) of the local board having jurisdiction over the area in which you are now located.  
 Failure to comply with this notice will result in your being declared a delinquent and subjected to the penalties provided by law.

Before appeal, a registrant may file a written request for appearance within the same ten-day period; and if he does so, the local board will fix a day and notify him to appear personally before the local board. If this is done, the time to appeal is extended to ten days beyond the day set by the local board for such appearance.
