Albert Webbink was born in Femme Osage the year the Civil War ended. He met and married Lina Klippel there and lived and worked there as a carpenter and coffin maker. His children were born there and grew to adolescence attending not only public school, but German school as well, held in a small building across from the Evangelical Church.

While living there, he and his sons worked as a carpenter crew, building and repairing houses. They also built the chapel on top of the hill at the Emmaus Home near Marthasville in Warren County, Missouri.

Toward the end of World War I he and his family joined a movement of a number of Femme Osage families to the Independence, Missouri area, in an attempt to upgrade their economic opportunities. The Webbinks rented a part of a railroad box car in which they moved all their household goods. By then Albert was in his fifties.. They bought a home on North Lynn Street in Independence. The property had a large barn on it which he converted to a carpenter shop. He and his sons resumed building and repairing homes. They also built a new home for the family at 826 North Noland in Independence.

Albert began to expand his economic holdings by buying homes, fixing them up and renting them. He owned around twenty homes at the time the depression hit. By the end of the depression, even his family home was mortgaged and all the others were no longer his.

He and his sons worked as a crew off and on when work could be found until World War II when the sons found work in defense industries.


After his wife Lina died in 1937, his daughter Lydia and her husband moved in with him. He spent his time working and reading in his carpenter shop, visiting with his sons who came regularly and was fairly active until he was felled by a heart attack in 1946.


